One Card

Students can submit their photo utilizing the <u>Student ID Online Photo Submission Form</u>. Once the ID has been processed, students will receive an email for appointment and pick up instructions, if needed OneCard is needed before Orientation. Students attending UMB for the first time on august 25 will pick up their OneCard at Orientation.

The Barcode/One Card number is available for Online/Virtual (All) Students who may need their number for exam entrance, library access, etc. and do not require a physical One Card ID at this time. The ID Barcode/One Card Number cannot be used as a replacement for the One Card Identification. Students can access their Barcode /One Card Number in the UMB Account Management Site – <u>Directory</u>.

The One Card Office is located in the SMC Campus Center, 621 West Lombard Street. Room 004, Lower Level. Upon arrival please have a valid government driver's license, passport, or other photo ID for verification of identity at the Guard Station and the One Card Office.
